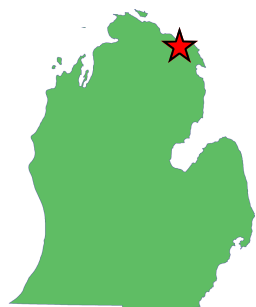


OUR SITE AND FACILITIES

OUR STAFF

Our **Cabin Counselors** and **Program Staffers** are college age and older adults who have experience working



with young people. Our staff-to-camper-ratio is one to five. All Staffers undergo a thorough background check prior to their service

with children. Staff members also participate in pre-camp orientation which includes basic first aid training, emergency procedure drills, behavior management and information related to the development characteristics and needs of the children in their care.

Camp Chickagami is committed to the health and safety of all campers and staff. Our full-time, on site **Health Officer** provides first aid and health care according to a licensed physician's standing orders.

Certified Lifeguards supervise all swimming and boating activities. An experienced **Cook** serves balanced, great tasting meals.

OUR CAMP SESSIONS

Youth Camp Sessions are intended to help young people come to more fully know and experience God's love for them and to help them live more fully into their Baptismal vows. We also strive to build the body of Christ amidst the young people of our diocese within our beautiful natural environment.



Campers participate in Christian Formation each morning. Themes vary by session but typically campers explore the theme through crafts, games,



music, dramatics, team-building exercises and small group discussions. Each day also brings lots of opportunities to participate

in a variety of recreational activities including swimming, boating, sports, hiking, fishing, exploring nature, working on even more crafts and joining in all camp evening activities. Each day's events are sandwiched between youth-friendly worship experiences.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR CAMP CHICK

Camp fees are \$215 for Junior Camp/ Counselor-in-Training and \$240 for Senior Camp. The difference in rates is due to the difference in length of the sessions. Camp fees provide lodging, meals, supervision, camp t-shirt, cabin group photo and all program materials. Please note that Camp Chick is unable to provide transportation at this time. **Each camper's family must provide or arrange transportation to/from camp.**

It is Camp Chickagami's policy that no camper will be turned away from camp due to limited financial resources. **Scholarship assistance** is available. Please contact our registrar for a scholarship form.

Space is limited. Campers will be registered on a first come, first served basis. If a session fills, campers may be put on a waiting list until such time as a space becomes available. Deposits will be returned to any campers we are unable to accommodate.

Watch for a registration packet to arrive in late April complete with detailed map, health form, packing list, a bunkmate request form and other materials.

All forms and the balance of fees are due **JUNE 15th**. **If the camp fee is paid in full by our June 15th deadline, we'll discount your session by \$20.**

If a camper must withdraw from camp for any reason, a refund, minus the deposit, will be issued if we're informed of cancellation prior to June 15th. **Those who cancel after June 15th forfeit the entire camp fee.**
