

OUR SITE AND FACILITIES



Campers will find **CAMP CHICKAGAMI** “off the beaten path” near Presque Isle – between Alpena and Rogers City in beautiful northern Michigan. Our 78+ mostly forested acres command the entire north shore of pristine Lake Esau as well as substantial

frontage on Lake Huron’s Albany Bay.

Fine program areas and facilities such as our campfire circle, craft hut, hiking and nature trails, newly resurfaced tennis court, outdoor chapel, boat house complete with canoes, paddleboats, sail and rowboats, and a sandy beach with swimming docks and rafts create opportunities galore for fun and learning.

Comfortable dorm style cabins, with nearby modern bathhouses, provide lodging for campers and staff.

Cabin Counselors and Program Staffers are college age and older adults who have experience working with young people. Staffers undergo a thorough background check and participate pre-camp orientation which includes emergency procedure drills and information related to the developmental characteristics and needs of the children in their care.

Each of our sessions is also staffed by a **Chaplain** who provides worship leadership and pastoral support for campers and staff.

We are committed to the health and safety of all campers and staff. Our full-time, on site **Health Officer** provides first aid and health care according to a licensed physician’s standing orders. **Certified Lifeguards** supervise all swimming and boating activities. An experienced **Cook** serves well balanced, great tasting meals.

Camp Chickagami’s Youth Camps are licensed by the State of Michigan and are inspected annually to ensure compliance with required standards concerning the health and safety of our campers.

OUR CAMP SESSIONS

Youth Camps are intended to help young people come to more fully know and experience God's love for them and to help them live more fully into their Baptismal vows. We also strive to build community amongst the young people of the diocese.



Campers participate in Christian Formation each morning. Themes vary by session but

typically we explore themes through small group discussions, crafts, games, music, dramatics and teambuilding exercises.

Campers are also invited to participate in a wide variety of daily recreational activities including swimming, boating, sports, hiking, fishing, crafts and nature exploration. Each evening brings a spectacular all-camp evening activity like Campfires, Skit Nights, Water Carnivals, Six Socks, and much more! Each session brings a road trip to nearby Ocqueoc Falls (below) too!



Each day's events are sandwiched between child/ youth-friendly worship experiences.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR CAMP CHICKAGAMI

Camp fees are \$250 for all three sessions. Camp fees provide lodging, meals, supervision, camp t-shirt, cabin group photo and all program materials. Please note that Camp Chickagami is unable to provide transportation. **Each camper's family must provide or arrange transportation to/from camp.**

Are you a Senior camper interested in our Counselor in Training Program? Stay two weeks at a discounted rate; ask about our Saturday stay-over option.

It is Camp Chickagami's policy that no camper will be turned away from camp due to limited financial resources. **Scholarship assistance** is available. Please contact our registrar for a scholarship form.

Space is limited. Campers will be registered on a first come, first served basis. If a session fills, campers may be put on a waiting list until such time as a space becomes available. Deposits will be returned to any campers we are unable to accommodate.

All forms and the balance of fees are due JUNE 15th. **If the camp fee is paid in full by the June 15th deadline (and all forms are on file) we'll discount your session by \$25.**

If a camper must withdraw from camp for any reason, a refund, minus the deposit, will be issued if we are informed of cancellation prior to June 15th. **Those who cancel after June 15th forfeit the entire camp fee.**
